





We love these light, bright contemporary holiday apartments created out of barn buildings at The Old Granary. The clients' choice of grey limed look vinyl wood flooring, plain white walls with oak doors, balustrading and exposed beams creates a clean, minimalist style.

The kitchen areas are uncluttered: gloss white subway tiles with bevelled edges laid in a traditional stretcher brick bond pattern above a seamless light grey worktop. Sinks are undermounted with drainage grooves integrated into the countertop whilst the monobloc tap subtly nods to farm kitchens of earlier times.









Kitchen units, finished in neutral colours with unobtrusive stainless steel handles, are discreet and simple. Together the designer and owners have created delightfully restful, comfortable and calm spaces to make visitors feel very welcome indeed.

The apartments have subtle differences which make each space unique whilst keeping the same pared back colour scheme, tiling and flooring throughout. In the larger Gable apartment, the kitchen features Shaker style unit fronts for a more homely feel, whilst the Mill apartment gives off a modern vibe with flat-fronted units. 



Extractor Fans

There are many ways to rid your kitchen of steam, odour and grease created by cooking. You can have a fan that is hidden 'in plain sight', disguised as a lighting fixture, a pop-up downdraft extractor, or even a fan that's integrated within the hob to avoid an overhead installation.

Pop-up downdraft hoods are ideal for hobs on island units as they are installed inside the worktop and suitable for use with any hob. They allow an unobstructed view of your kitchen with the benefit of a sleek, clean surface when not in use.

Another option is to choose a hood which doubles up as overhead lighting. Make your extractor hood a clever design feature, rather than purely practical.

Integrated venting hobs have the extraction hood built into the hob surface providing highly effective removal of steam and odours. They are an ideal solution for an island unit as you will not have to install a wall or ceiling hood.





After discussion with the client, it was decided that it in order to make room for a separate shower, an internal wall would have to be removed. Whilst being a big decision for the client, it has certainly paid off! The shower, glass enclosure and bath are all from the same range and work together to create a modern look with distinct lines.

Designer Greg, from our Boston showroom, worked closely with the client to create this bathroom. A key feature in the room is the double-ended bath, ensuring that this space is one of luxury. Comfort is created using two big feature towel warmers by Zehnder in Volcanic Grey, chosen for their effective heat emissions.

Fitted furniture, toilet, basin and bath taps are all by Roper Rhodes. The slimline design makes it easy to move around in the space with a large, wide-format LED illuminated mirror that floods the bathroom with light.

The transformation has turned a very dated, dark room into a beautifully bright space that is luxurious and modern. Both client and designer are happy with the end result.







